#### **GSMS Community Sponsored Agriculture**

Join the Community Sponsored Agriculture (CSA) at Good Shepherd and receive *more* than delicious, sustainably grown fruits and vegetables each week. CSA members also receive invaluable, hands-on *education* about regenerative farming. Members work alongside Farmer Theri, fellow CSA members, and other volunteers passionate about personal, community, and environmental health.

#### Two Membership Options Available

**Working Membership** — Our most popular membership. In May, join us on Saturday mornings from 8–10:00 a.m. From June through October, join us on Wednesday or Saturday from 7—10:00 a.m. for a work-to-learn CSA experience. You will work with other community members to grow, maintain, and harvest a diverse variety of produce. You will receive a fair share of weekly produce equaling roughly **3/4 bushel** and access to bulk amounts when they are available.

If a full membership is too big, you can share your membership (1/2 membership) with a friend. See the membership agreement for more details.

Work Days: May 11-September 7, 2025 and independent harvesting until season ends in November.
