October 1: Special Parent Education Night

Wednesday, October 1 6:00-7:30 p.m.

We are pleased to welcome speakers from the <u>CASIE Center</u> for an important Parent Education Night (PEN) on Wednesday, October 1. They will share information about their body safety and child abuse prevention program, which will be implemented at Good Shepherd this school year.

The CASIE Center delivers this program in schools throughout St. Joseph County, in compliance with the state of Indiana's 2017 mandate, known as Erin's Law. Designed by the Monique Burr Foundation for Children, the curriculum used by the CASIE Center is research-based and age-appropriate. It teaches students of all ages to recognize signs of abuse and identify a "safe adult" that they can talk to.

At least one parent from each GSMS family is expected to attend, which counts for one hour toward your family's Family Parent Cooperative (FPC) commitment.

👸 🐂 River Birch Atrium Assistant


