✨ Thursday, December 18 is Pajama and Ice Skating Day! ✨

On the last day before Christmas break, it's GSMS tradition for students to wear their pajamas to school and spend the morning participating in fun activities with their classmates. In the afternoon, younger and older students follow **different schedules**.

Primary Early Dismissal

Ice Skating for LE, UE, & JH

All Lower El, Upper El, and Junior High students will spend the afternoon ice skating at Howard Park.

#1. Online GSMS Ice Skating Form – Due December 10

- All families with LE, UE, or JH students must fill out the online "GSMS Pajama Day Ice Skating" form to participate in ice skating (use [this link](#) or the **ORANGE** button below).

- This form gives parents important information and collects children's skate sizes.
- Please submit the form no later than **TOMORROW, Wednesday, December 10**.
- We have had MANY families return the paper waiver but not fill out this online form, so make sure you do this critical step.

#2. Ice Skating Waiver – Due December 15

- All skaters need a **signed Howard Park waiver** to skate.
- A **GREEN copy of the waiver** was sent home with all children in LE, UE, and JH on Friday, December 5.
- You can also download the waiver [PDF] by clicking on the purple button below.
- Signed waivers can be returned in your child's folder or dropped off at the front desk.

December Challenge



The rest of the year, users earn 1% back on all their purchases, which goes to Good Shepherd.

LAST CHANCE for December Bonus

Converting to an ELEVATE card can take 10 to 14 days, so **act now** if you want to help GSMS earn the December bonus! There are several ways to get an ELEVATE card—See instructions below.



Get Your ELEVATE Card

If you already use Notre Dame Federal Credit Union, it is pretty simple to **convert your debit card to an ELEVATE card**.

1. Call the downtown branch at 574-400-4820. Ask for Hannah Ellito or Jasmin Coria. One of them will be happy to assist you.
2. Call the Shamrock Call Center: 800-522-6611
3. Visit any branch to request an ELEVATE card in person.
4. You can apply for a card online, but if you already have an NDFCU debit card, it's **best** to call or visit a branch to make sure everything is handled correctly.

Qualifying Transactions

Once you have your ELEVATE debit card, **use it like a credit card—without the PIN—**

Once between now and December 31. Making a purchase online is the easiest way to do this! Joint accounts with two ELEVATE debit cards count as “one swipe,” so either account owner can make the qualifying purchase.

If you aren't currently a member at NDFCU, that's OK. There will be other opportunities to fundraise for GSMS.




NURSE'S CORNER

Winter is definitely here, and it has brought along its good friends: cold and flu. And tagging along as the third wheel this year is strep!

Below is a quick infographic to help you figure out what your child may be dealing with if they come home not feeling well. If their symptoms are leaning more toward the flu side, some good rest and hydration at home are the way to go.

If your child is complaining of a severe sore throat that comes on suddenly, has a fever and/or pain when swallowing, but doesn't really have a cough or congestion, those are classic symptoms of strep and may be worth getting checked out by your child's doctor. 
